### Outstanding Club Award

To qualify for Outstanding Club Award, Clubs must meet the following requirements: -

1. Report Service projects/events to MyLion on or before 28<sup>th</sup> of each calendar month.
2. District Dues paid in advance on yearly basis latest by 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022, or in two (2) semi-annual payments latest by 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022 and 15<sup>th</sup> February 2023 respectively.
3. Club is in Good Standing. Not in Status Quo or Financial suspension, District Dues paid and no unpaid balance with LCI greater than US\$50 outstanding 90 days or more.
4. Achieved a net growth of 1 in membership.
5. Report members monthly via MyLCI, even if there are no changes to the roster. Review and Update the Club Roster.
6. Report Club Officers (FY 2023-2024) to MyLCI by 15<sup>th</sup> April 2023.
7. 2 Officers and 2 Members participate in at least 2 of the Leadership training events organized by the District.

8. Orientation for new Members done within 2 months after acceptance/induction.
9. Club President, Club First Vice President or Club Treasurer, and Club Secretary attended Three (First, Second and Third) District Governor's Advisory Committee meeting (Zone meeting). Fourth District Governor's Advisory Committee meeting is optional.
